POSITION: Maintenance Intern
RESPONSIBLE TO: Maintenance Director

QUALIFICATIONS:

3. Is eager to learn, enjoys working with people, and has a desire to see individuals come to know and grow in Christ.

6. Regular bending, twisting, and working from heights is required.
7. Ability to drive basic automobiles (Class D license).
8. Self-motivated; able to work alone and with others.

GENERAL OVERVIEW:

The Maintenance Internship is a full-time position, 40+ hours per week, assisting the Maintenance Director with maintenance and improvement of camp property, including facilities, vehicles, and grounds. This position will provide the opportunity to engage in hands-on learning in a variety of environments, including construction, repair, and vehicle maintenance. A desire to learn and an attention to detail are traits that will allow the maintenance intern to excel.

RESPONSIBILITIES:

1. Be a witness for Jesus Christ in all words and actions, and share Christ's love with the public, campers, and staff to reflect favorably upon the Lord and Camp Victory.
2. Develop a Christ-like, servant atmosphere in the work area.
3. Participate in personal, spiritual, and professional development.
4. Assist with routine clean-up and basics of facility upkeep and repairs.
5. Engage in hands-on projects and tasks.
6. Complete weekly trash pick-up and drop off.
7. Provide assistance to guests, set up meeting rooms, clean any necessary buildings, help in the kitchen during meals, help run programs such as the challenge course, archery or other program activities as needed.
8. Perform all other duties as assigned by the Maintenance Director and Camp Directors.
